1 HSC Responsibilities and scope for work:

- 1.1 Ensure the compliance with the sharia requirements in all activities of the Forum through;
 - a) Develop policies and principles relating to sharia requirements of IHAF activities.
 - b) Review draft accreditation schemes presented to the BOD of IHAF
 - c) Review documents issued by technical and MLA committees presented to the BOD of IHAF.
 - d) Review the requirements and criteria for qualifying the sharia peer evaluators.
 - 1.2 Coordinate with the International Islamic Fiqh Academy regarding to the Sharia requirements.
 - 1.3. Encouraging and supervising researches and studies, which aim to overcome the technical difficulties facing the development of Halal products, in order to adapt them to the Sharia requirements.
 - 1.4 Review and submit recommendation regarding with complaints and appeals related to the sharia issues

2 Committee Formation and Membership

- <u>2.1</u> The IHAF member of IHAF HSRC shall be nominated from IHAF Halal Accreditation Bodies with accreditation knowledge as well as practical experience for at least one year in halal accreditation.
- 2.2 Members from International Islamic Figh Academy / OIC
- <u>2.3</u> All members of the committee shall sign IHAF Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct.
